 Clue 3

We will start this clue with a square in a square in a square....there aren't many, so maybe we will do more...let's just see how long it takes us!

Cutting first, as usual.

<u>LIGHT</u>	<i>Lap</i>	<i>Twin</i>	<i>Queen</i>	<i>King</i>
4-1/2" WOF strip	1	1	1	1
-sub-cut to 4-1/2" squares	3	1	4	7
<u>MEDIUM</u>	<i>Lap</i>	<i>Twin</i>	<i>Queen</i>	<i>King</i>
5-1/4" WOF strips	1	1	1	1
-sub-cut to 5-1/4" squares	3	1	4	7
-cut squares on <i>BOTH</i> diagonals for triangles	12	4	16	28
<u>DARK</u>	<i>Lap</i>	<i>Twin</i>	<i>Queen</i>	<i>King</i>
4-7/8" WOF strips	1	1	1	2
-sub-cut to 4-7/8" squares	6	2	8	14
-cut squares on <i>ONE</i> diagonal for triangles	12	4	16	28

Grab your LIGHT squares and your MEDIUM triangles and we will start there. We will find the centre of each of these by folding in half and finger pressing. Mate these centre points and stitch down the side of the square. Square the first set to 6" - 6-1/8". Once the second set is on, this should measure 8-1/2", watch your points so you don't lose them.



I know we can do more, because that didn't take very long. SO, let's build some houses. We are going to create two (2) different sizes of houses in this clue. One will be 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" and the other will be 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" today. I have provided the template for the house and roof, however, if you don't want to use the template for the roof, you can cut a 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" rectangle and cut on one diagonal (you will need to do these mirror image... cut two at a time with your fabrics RST -right sides together- so you can get a left and right roof). Now, let's do this!

5-1/2" WOF strips	3	2	2	3
-sub cut to 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles	30	18	24	30
-sub cut to 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles	10	6	8	10

MEDIUM	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
3-1/4" WOF strips	2	1	2	2
-sub cut to 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" rectangles	40	24	32	40
-cut rectangles on ONE diagonal (mirror image) for triangles	40 SETS (80 triangles)	24 SETS (48 triangles)	32 SETS (64 triangles)	40 SETS (80 triangles)
OR USE TEMPLATES	40 SETS (80 triangles)	24 SETS (48 triangles)	32 SETS (64 triangles)	40 SETS (80 triangles)

Using the MEDIUM smaller triangles as your "roof", assemble the houses as shown. Your smaller houses (one story) will measure 3-1/2" by 2-1/2" and the larger houses (two story) will measure 5-1/2" by 2-1/2". Please press toward the "roof" and trim to those sizes. I would trim off the bottom if they are too large. This way you are less likely to lose the point.

The smaller house is pictured here, please note how the smaller MEDIUM triangle hangs over BOTH ends of our house. It is like this with both houses.
