

## Gingham Style © Debi Montgomery Fabric Requirements

*I love the “retro” look of gingham in this pattern, hence the name!! I hope you love this one as much as I do. I can’t wait to get started...*

*For this quilt you will need four fabrics (our sets of fabrics, if scrappy). You need a background and your main colour, these will need heaps of contrast. The other two fabrics need to play well with each other and the background and main colour. Since the “other” two fabrics don’t require heaps of yardage, you can easily use a scrappy palette for these two fabrics. There are heaps of sizes to choose from, so be patient as I write the clues, math is NOT my strong suit!! All sizes and yardages are BEFORE BORDERS.*
