

**Ke Aloha**  
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**Clue 5**

**LAST CLUE BEFORE THE REVEAL!!** We will be creating some large units and cutting some small ones, so grab your scraps and yardage and let's get to it!

First we will cut for our units, follow the top cutting chart for the clues, bottom cutting chart for the added squares to finish up before the next clue.

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
DARK 6-1/2" strips	1	1	1	1
-cut to 6-1/2" squares	4	4	4	4
MEDIUM 6-7/8" strips	1	1	1	1
-cut to 6-7/8" squares	4	4	4	4
-cut on ONE diagonal for triangles	8	8	8	8
LIGHT 12-7/8" strips	1	1	1	1
-cut to 12-7/8" squares	2	2	2	2
-cut on ONE diagonal for triangles	4	4	4	4

Here is our deconstructed block for today. This will be 12-1/2" today to finish at 12" in our quilt.



Taking the smaller triangles and the square, let's complete the right hand side (in the pic) triangle. You will sew the MEDIUM triangles to adjacent sides of the square first. From here we will sew the larger LIGHT triangle onto the left hand side.

Our finished unit:



Now we have some final cutting to do before we assemble in the final clue!

Here are the last of the units to cut, just a few LIGHT 2-1/2" squares.

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
LIGHT 2-1/2" strips	1	2	3	5
-cut to 2-1/2" squares	16	28	48	68

I think we can assemble some more units today, we haven't done too much for one clue...

Let's add those HSTs from Clue 4 and the flying geese from Clue 3 and these 2-1/2" squares and make some units:



You will make the bottom unit (in the pic) first. Then take those and add a 2-1/2" square on both sides of half those units.

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
8-1/2" units	8	14	24	34
12-1/2" units	8	14	24	34

And that's it!!! Just putting them into place next clue and WE ARE IN FOR ANOTHER BEAUTIFUL QUILT!!
