

Ninja Training
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Clue 5 REVEAL

Since we have done all of our cutting in previous clues, we can just get right down to putting this wee babe together. I have had heaps of fun with this QUICK project. I also had quite a bit more fabric left over than I anticipated. All the better to add a LIGHT border to make it all "float".

Please watch placement of the flying geese blocks as you won't want your gaggle to have a riot!

Here she is in all her cuteness.



We need to make three more blocks on top of the ones we finished in Clue 1 and the ones we cut in Clue 2. Let's work on the "most" block first. This one requires ALL the flying geese we've made, the 3-colour hourglass units, and the cut LIGHT units from Clue 3... WOW! You may want to starch or Best Press these, they will stretch, usually from top to bottom.



For the top block (with the flying geese) I sewed the top two and bottom two "rows" into strip sets, then the middle row followed. These three "rows" went together easily then. PLEASE make sure you take the proper seam allowance.



Then "Friendship Star" blocks in two different colourways.



I will add a final LIGHT border to make all my "ninja" stars float around. ENJOY!
