Clue 2

Without taking a breath, let's carry on with two of the same unit in different colourways. We will be using all three of our colours today.

Let's get cutting:

DARK 4-1/2" strips	6
-cut to 4-1/2" squares	48
MEDIUM 2-1/2" strips	3
-cut to 2-1/2" squares	48
LIGHT 2-1/2" strips	3
-cut to 2-1/2" squares	48

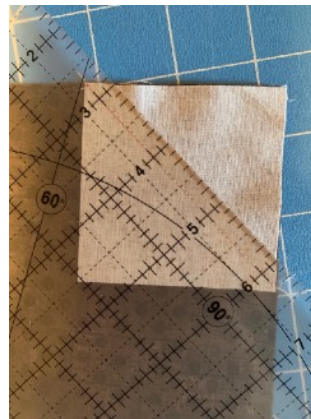
Because I am limited on my fabric, I took my Clue 1 strips sets and had a date with Jill (Jack's little sister) to pull them apart to use the 2-12" strips, If you do this, it may take less strips cut.

Draw a diagonal line on the **WRONG** side of your MEDIUM and LIGHT squares. You will need **24** DARK/MEDIUM units and **24** DARK/LIGHT units.



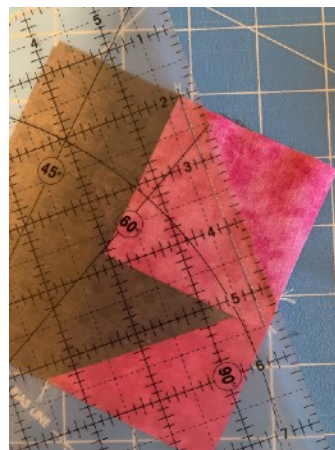
SAVE YOUR SCRAPS!!

Now, starting with your favourite colour and side, sew ON THE LINE (I sewed just to the outside of the line to take the fold into account), to put a triangle corner on the square.



You will then cut off the bonus triangle, lying your 1/4" line on the seam line. Save those bonus triangles, we may want them for the border. Press toward the corner triangle.

Now set another square on the adjacent side making sure your lines cross in an "x" in the top AND you stay light with light and medium with medium, and sew on that line again, trimming to 1/4", press toward the corner triangle.



You will have 24 DARK/LIGHT and 24 DARK/MEDIUM 4-1/2" units that should look like these:
