 Clue 2

Clue 2 for this super quick project!! Both sizes of this quilt need the exact same amount of these units so everyone will cut the same! Easy...let's get started!

Background	Both Sizes
<i>10" WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Cut to 10" squares</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>5-1/4" WOF strip</i>	<i>1</i>
<i>Cut to 5-1/4" squares</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>4-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Cut to 4-7/8" squares</i>	<i>10</i>
<i>Cut on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>	<i>20</i>
<i>4-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>Cut to 4-1/2" squares</i>	<i>40</i>

Pop	Both Sizes
<i>10" WOF strip</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Cut to 10" squares</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>5-1/4" WOF strip</i>	<i>1</i>
<i>Cut to 5-1/4" squares</i>	<i>5</i>
<i>4-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>3</i>
<i>Cut to 4-1/2" squares</i>	<i>20</i>

Contrast	Both Sizes
<i>10" WOF strips</i>	<i>3</i>
<i>Cut to 10" squares</i>	<i>10</i>

Contrast	Both Sizes
5-1/4" WOF strips	2
Cut to 5-1/4" squares	10
4-7/8" WOF strip	2
Cut to 4-7/8" squares	10
Cut on ONE diagonal for triangles	20

Let's get started!! We will walk down each of the charts and start with the 10" squares. We need to draw an "X" on the back of each contrast (or your lightest fabric.) We should have one contrast for every pop and one contrast for every background. Let's mate them that way and make some HSTs using the magic 8 method. You may assemble your HSTs any method you choose, just so they end up at 4-1/2" before moving on. We did this in clue 1, so I won't repeat myself. Here are mine cut and ready to press and trim:



Now for those 5-1/4" squares, we will again draw a diagonal line (just one this time) on the back of the lightest fabric. You should have one contrast for each pop and background again. You will now stitch 1/4" away from both sides of the line. Following the stitching, we will cut on BOTH diagonals, leaving us with two-colour triangles. We will mate these triangles with the 4-7/8" triangles according to colour.



Your background will mate with the two-coloured triangle that has the background fabric. The contrast will mate with the two-colour triangle that has the pop fabric.

You should have everything you need now to assemble our units for today. These should measure 12-1/2" and be pressed in the easiest way possible.
