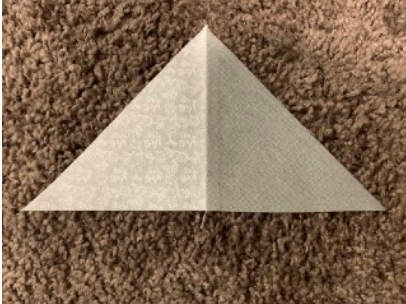

We will be using our MEDIUM and our LIGHT to make some triangles.

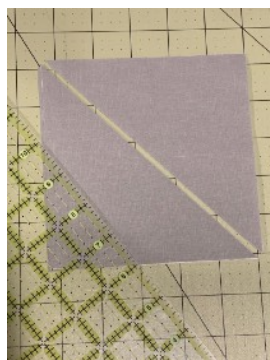
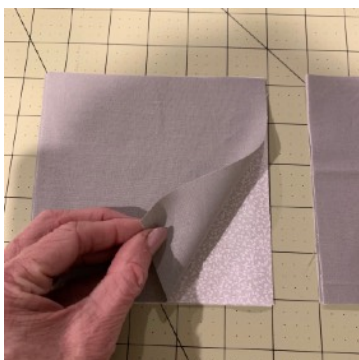


This is our finished unit for today. PLACEMENT IS SO IMPORTANT! Your LIGHT must be on the LEFT and the MEDIUM must be on the RIGHT. So let's get started.

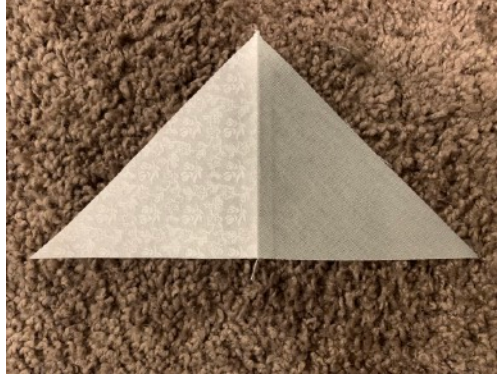
We will be using our MEDIUM and LIGHT to cut these units:

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
LIGHT 5-1/4" strips	2	3	4	4
-cut to 5-1/4" squares	13	18	25	32
-cut to triangles	52	72	100	128
MEDIUM 5-1/4" strips	2	3	4	4
-cut to 5-1/4" squares	13	18	25	32
-cut to triangles	52	72	100	128

I cut all my squares first. I then laid them RST (LIGHT on MEDIUM), to cut to triangles to sew. We will cut them on each diagonal.



We now take those triangles (kept just as they are) and sew with the LIGHT on the top starting at the 90° angle and finishing at the point. It is hard to tell you how to measure this. If you start at the 90° angle and measure the LIGHT short un-sewn side, it should be about 4-1/2" as should it's MEDIUM counterpart. ***These pics are medium on light, I had to flip them when I sewed them.*** PLACEMENT IS IMPORTANT.***



Please trim your dog ears and press these toward the LIGHT for future ease of sewing and accuracy.

Final unit count for each size:

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
Total Triangle Units	52	72	100	128
