Clue 6 REVEAL

Using your left over Clue 2 HST, Clue 3 hourglass units, and Clue 4 LIGHT/MEDIUM flying geese, make the charted amount of hourglass blocks as pictured.



Once our HGs blocks are put together, we will use our variety of star blocks from clues 3 and 5, the pieced border finished in clue 4 to finish our top. I finished with one DARK 3-1/2" border all around. It took me (for the twin) (8) DARK 3-1/2" strips. You will need to start with an X block in the top left corner (as you look at it) for your border to work properly. You will use the special X blocks from Clue 5 for the corners and outside X blocks, all other 4-flying geese units are for the centre of your quilt top. Remember to rotate your 2 and 3-patch flying geese units to "finish" the outside blocks.

Use the chart to determine how many hourglass blocks you need as well as how many total blocks across and down:

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
Hourglass Blocks	10	17	21	36
Across	4	5	6	9
Down	5	7	7	8

Here is the layout and my finished DouDou...
