

Starry Compass

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Clue 4

Just a few more units and we are ready to put Starry Compass together! It's such a beautiful quilt.

Today we are going to make some flying geese. You can choose your favourite method to make these. They will FINISH at 3" x 6" **IN** the quilt. They will be 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" today. We will be making them in two colour ways as well. DARK body with MEDIUM wings, and LIGHT body with MEDIUM wings.

Here are our finished units for today. We will sew a MEDIUM "wing" to each short side of the larger triangles to put them together. These may be a bit big and need trimmed down.



I am giving you the measurements for the "No Waste Flying Geese" method here, but you can accomplish these however you choose.

	Lap	Twin	Queen	King
MEDIUM 4" strips	3	4	6	8
-cut to 4" squares	*26	36	56	72
LIGHT 7-1/2" strips	2	2	3	4
-cut to 7-1/2" squares	*7	9	14	18
DARK 7-1/2" strips	2	2	3	4
-cut to 7-1/2" squares	*7	9	14	18

*Please note with the LAP, you will cut more not use all your flying geese. You will only need 26 of each colour way. You will be making 28.

I usually cut the larger squares on BOTH diagonals to get four "bodies". Then, I cut the smaller squares on ONE diagonal to get the wings.

You may also use the no waste method (YouTube and Google have heaps of tutorials) to accomplish these. Have fun with it. Please use the chart below to determine your requirements...
