Fabric Requirements

I am super excited to get our quilt along under way. I just love this pattern and I know others have loved it and will love making it again. I love this one so much, it is currently on my bed!

I have included all sizes in this quilt along. Can't wait to see what fabrics and size you choose! Please watch the chart for your size and requirements. This includes a wee (LIGHT) border and a buffer for boo-boos. You may want to make sure you have extra fabric for your border if you don't want light.

LIGHT	3 yards	4-1/2 yards	5-1/4 yards	7-3/4 yards
MEDIUM	1-1/4 yards	1-5/8 yards	2 yards	3 yards
DARK	1-5/8 yards	2-1/2 yards	3 yards	4-7/8 yards

Just a few suggestions:

I would NOT choose a directional for any part of this quilt. I don't want you to be frustrated with getting them all nice and symmetrical!

You can choose two fabrics of the same colour for the LIGHT and DARK, like dark and light blue, black and white, brown and tan. Then your MEDIUM or POP colour should be a contrast to these two. I chose dark brown (DARK), tan (LIGHT), and red (MEDIUM or POP).



You can go monochrome, just make sure you have GREAT contrast. Since you know what the quilt looks like, you can plug your fabrics into the spots in your mind! Also, I went scrappy on my LIGHT and MEDIUM as I didn't have enough of each of those to make the KING size that I made!! So go for the scrappy palette!!

There are some special rulers we will use for this quilt. I have included a template for one part that there is no template out there for in clue 4, I think!! But other than that, we will be using the "Recs" part of your Tri-Recs ruler, and your favourite flying geese ruler. BUT, I have also included templates for those pieces as well. You could get by with NO rulers except for your straight edge for this one. So, grab your fabric, ruler, and rotary cutter and LET'S GET STARTED!

There is a tricky part, but I will do a video for that clue so you can watch step by step. I will walk you through. And you know I am always here to help!!
