**Fabric Requirements**

*You are going to love this project we have for you. I (Debi) learned a new technique and had heaps of fun in the process! We will be making Blustery Buddies throughout the next few weeks, maybe even months depending on how fast we cut and sew. I am really looking forward to working with Coleen throughout this fun project!*

*SO, for this project you can just make the centre and call it a day, or you can add some extras, which we have ready for you and will come a little later, so I have given you two options below to choose from...one is just the centre, the other includes the extras!!*

	Centre Only (35")	With the Extras (the sky is the limit!!)
Background	3/4 yard	2 yards
Dark	2/3 yard	2 yards
Light	2/3 yard	3 yards
Accent 1	1/8 yard	1/8 yard
Accent 2	1/8 yard	3 yards

*For the best result possible, I would use BLACK for the DARK and WHITE for the LIGHT. For the background, I chose a cloudy blue (which worked perfectly!!), and for the Accents, Orange for accent 1 is perfect. Accent 2 is truly your choice, I chose red. For Accent 2 I would choose red IF doing all the extras, you will use this red again throughout the entire quilt. When picking fabrics, think COLD thoughts, remember "BLUSTERY" Buddies. This is a fantastic winter quilt!*

*You also need a kaleidoscope ruler. This ruler has 45° angles. We used the Kaleido-Ruler by Marti Mitchell. Coleen used the small one while Debi used the large one, both work. The smaller one is definitely easier for this project, but BOTH work well!*

*With the extras, these yardages are only guesses as you can go as far as you want, you may use less, you may use more...this is kinda an average, a happy medium! You can go totally scrappy for the Accent 2 fabric...I did! I just stayed red, you could choose any colour here, just stay close to colour. Here are my choices, let's see yours.....*
