

Double Take © Debi Montgomery Clue 1

Let's make some HSTs today for a double take double easy block. We will be using our **BACKGROUND** and our **POP** fabrics for these and they are all the same size to complete these. All sizes will need eight (8).

Easy to cut and assemble!

BACKGROUND and POP	ALL SIZES
14" WOF strips	2
Sub-cut to 14" squares*	4

* I laid my strips **RST** (right sides together) one **POP** with one **BACKGROUND** before I cut down to the 14" squares, this way they are ready to go!

We will assemble these HSTs using the easy 8 (magic 8) method. Let's begin by drawing an "X" on the wrong side of our background fabric squares.



Now, we stitch 1/4" to the right and left of our lines.

Once our stitches look like a "double" X on the squares, we need to take them to our cutting board and make four cuts. Our first cuts will be 7" from the side and 7" from the top:



Easy cutting now, we cut **ON** our drawn lines.



We will now have 8 (eight) units from each set of 14" squares to take to the ironing board. Once pressed toward the darker fabric, we need to trim these beauties down to 6-1/2".



All our pre-work is finished, we need to put this beauty together like this:

I sewed this like a 4-patch, creating the top section followed by the bottom section. They are EXACTLY alike, so just keep sewing!!



Our finished 12-1/2" units will look like this. I also pinwheel pressed the centre seams to take out the bulk. This left me with a cutesy little section on the back!

ALL SIZES will have 8 (eight). All should measure 12-1/2" and be pressed flat.
