*Let's make some strip sets for this gorgeous "double" fun quilt!! I am so excited to start this! These measurements may be doubly hard (we are cutting 1/8th and 1/4s), but the end result is pretty amazing. We are putting these together the easy, strip-set way...too much fun!*

<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<i>Lap</i>	<i>Twin</i>	<i>Queen/King</i>
<i>4-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>3</i>	<i>4</i>	<i>9</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 3-1/4" x 4-1/2" rectangles</i>	<i>8</i>	<i>16</i>	<i>32</i>
<i>AND 7-1/4" x 4-1/2" rectangles</i>	<i>8</i>	<i>16</i>	<i>32</i>
<i>3-1/4" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	<i>2</i>	<i>4</i>
<i>1-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>3</i>	<i>3</i>	<i>5</i>
<b>MEDIUM</b>	<i>Lap</i>	<i>Twin</i>	<i>Queen/King</i>
<i>1-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>5</i>	<i>8</i>	<i>14</i>
<b>POP</b>	<i>Lap</i>	<i>Twin</i>	<i>Queen/King</i>
<i>1-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>	<i>5</i>	<i>8</i>

*We will sew the 1-7/8" strips together into strip-sets. We need BACKGROUND/MEDIUM/POP and MEDIUM/POP/MEDIUM. We will also need to create strip-sets using the 3-1/4" BACKGROUND and 1-7/8" MEDIUM strips. Our strip-sets should look like this now:*



Now we will cut these down into 1-7/8" units. These strips should be 1-7/8" x 4-1/2" now. Here's a sampling of what we have now:



We need to cut:

M/P/M units: Lap=12, Twin=24, Queen,King=48

P/M/B units: Lap=24, Twin=48, Queen,King=96

B/M: Lap=16, Twin=32, Queen,King=64

We will set aside the BACKGROUND/MEDIUM units for this next step to work with the three-fabric strip-sets. Let's make some 9-patch units:



These 9-patch units should be 4-1/2" squares now.

After assembly, here's what we should have so far:



Finally, we will grab those BACKGROUND rectangles we haven't used to finish off this double chain double beauty. Using your 2-fabric strips and these rectangles, let's assemble these:



Our 12-1/2" units should look similar to this when complete:

*Mid-Construction:*



Complete for today, our units should measure 12-1/2". We did have to cut a bit large, so you may have to trim just a sliver to correct the size. Aren't they amazing! Lap size should have 4 (four), Twin should have 8 (eight) and Queen and King should have 16 (sixteen) of these for today.
