Clue 3

Here we are at the “hump” clue (nearly half finished) with a new design. This is so much fun... only a couple more clues til we see this amazing design pop! We will be making setting triangles for our finished quilt today (hint, hint). Really easy clue! Let’s just jump right in...

All cutting for this clue:

ACCENT 2	<i>Lap and Twin</i>	<i>Queen and King</i>
<i>11-1/2” WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	<i>1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 11-1/2” squares</i>	<i>2</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Cut these squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>	<i>4</i>	<i>4</i>
<i>8-1/2” WOF strips</i>	<i>Leftovers + 1</i>	<i>Leftovers + 2</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 8-1/2” squares</i>	<i>10</i>	<i>14</i>
<i>Cut these squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>	<i>20</i>	<i>28</i>
FOCUS	<i>Lap and Twin</i>	<i>Queen and King</i>
<i>8” WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>	<i>3</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 8” squares</i>	<i>10</i>	<i>14</i>

EASY cutting for today!! That’s it. We just have a little sewing to do and we are ready for the next clue!

We will set aside the 11-1/2” squares we cut on ONE diagonal for use later. Everyone will have four of these.

Using those 8-1/2” ACCENT 2 triangles and the 8” FOCUS squares, let’s assemble some larger triangles. Easy and done for this clue!!!! Press these toward the triangles. Lap and twin will have 10 triangles (the square sides should measure ~15-7/8”). Queen and king will have 14 of these triangles.

These are setting triangles and are ready to go!
