

Kaleidoscope Stars
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Clue 4

Nearing the end of this beauty now! Let's get busy and make some units today for some of the remaining blocks left for this design. I just know you are going to be so proud of your accomplishments with this one!

We are cutting some HSTs, but it saves fabric to use the 2 at a time method rather than the magic 8. Please ask if you want to use the magic (easy) 8 method, I will give you those large square sizes.

Cutting comes first! Watch for your chosen size. ALSO, PLEASE USE LEFTOVERS FROM PREVIOUS CLUES FIRST, then cut what you need from your yardage.

BACKGROUND	<i>Lap and Twin</i>	<i>Queen and King</i>
<i>8-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>Leftovers + 1</i>	<i>Leftovers + 2</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 8-1/2" squares</i>	6	10
ACCENT 2	<i>Lap and Twin</i>	<i>Queen and King</i>
<i>8-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>Leftovers +1</i>	<i>Leftovers +</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 8-1/2" squares</i>	6	10
FOCUS	<i>Lap and Twin</i>	<i>Queen and King</i>
<i>8" WOF strips</i>	3	4
<i>Sub-cut to 8" squares</i>	12	20

Another easy clue cutting day!

We will use those 8-1/2" BACKGROUND and ACCENT 2 squares to create HSTs. We will draw one diagonal line on the wrong side of our BACKGROUND squares, followed by stitching 1/4" to the left and right of the line. Let's cut on the line, press toward the ACCENT 2 and square up to 8".



Deconstructed:



We will now lay out a 4-patch unit, stitch them together, pinwheel the centre seam, and we are done! Complete:

Make sure your HSTs are laid out like mine.... We will see why in a later clue!
