Fabric Requirements

This is a really fun design, quick and easy to accomplish. This design came about one evening as I was bored and needed a quick project to fill time. A couple days ago I was searching for fabrics for another project and these just spoke to me, so I rearranged some colours and blocks and this is what happened and I LOVE IT!! This is a three colour quilt, one being the background.

Your background needs to stay there so you can see your stars through the attic windows! I chose a vintage print as my "pop" of colour and pulled a darker colour out as my accent. My background is very neutral, but has a vine print running through. You can easily use a scrappy palette as your background... even your pop colours could be brights, vintage, fun kid prints... anything you want.

There are three sizes, everyone will make the centre of the design.. We will make it larger with frame borders. Our smallest size will be approximately 68" x 84". The medium one would fit a queen bed at 76" x 92" (with only 4" border... you could easily make it larger). The largest size has two borders and is approximately 88" x 104". I used my pop and accent fabrics as my borders.

Here's what we need by size:
