*SURPRISE!!!!!! I told you this one was quick and easy! Here we are at the reveal already. All we need to do is cut some setting triangles and we can lay out and finish this beauty. Let's get to it! I'll show you first, then you can check page 2 for those setting triangle measurements!*



*You will know you have it laid out correctly (in the centre) if you form that last star with those four centre blocks.*

*We are assembling this on point, diagonally not straight.*

<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<i>All Sizes</i>
<i>18-1/4" WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 18-1/4" squares</i>	<i>4</i>
<i>Cut these squares on BOTH diagonals for triangles</i>	<i>16 (we need 14)</i>
<i>9-3/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 9-3/8" squares</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Cut these squares on ONE diagonals for triangles</i>	<i>4</i>

*Those larger square triangles will be our setting triangles, the smaller ones will be in the four corners.*

*This is a great size now for a twin at 68" x 84".*

*Adding on a 4" (cut at 4-1/2") ACCENT border will give you a nice queen at 76" x 92".*

*I finished this off for a king by adding an ACCENT border to frame (cut at 4-1/2") followed by a POP border that I cut strips at 6-1/2". This landed me with a nice king size at 88" x 104".*

*Remember these are approximate sizes as this is set on point at a bit harder to measure accurately. Can't wait to see your stars from your attic windows...*
