 Clue 2 The Stars

*For my stars, I did them all the same. You can do whatever you wish for these units as long as they measure 12-1/2" before we sew this beauty together. All stars welcome!*

*For mine, I chose the "pinwheel" star, for lack of another catchy name that I don't know. Each of my sections measures 4-1/2" before assembly.*

*I took a pic of one of the scrappy ones I was working on. I will break this down into units for you.*



*For each block you will need:*

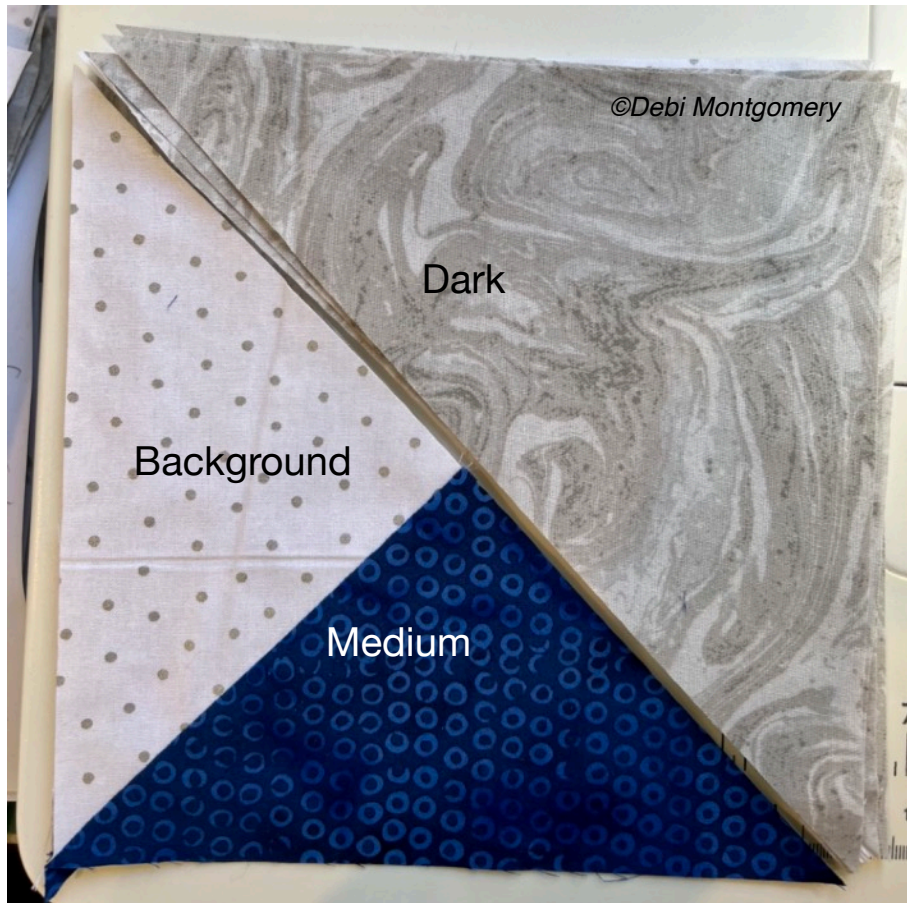
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	Each Star
5-1/4" squares	1
4-1/2" squares	4

<b>MEDIUM</b>	Each Star
5-1/4" squares	1
4-1/2" squares	1

<b>DARK</b>	Each Star
4-7/8" squares	2
Cut on ONE diagonal for triangles	4

*We will take those 5-1/4" squares and mate them BACKGROUND to MEDIUM with right sides together. I then cut on BOTH diagonals. Taking these squares to the sewing machine at starting at the 90° (square) angle, with the BACKGROUND on top, stitch at 1/4" seam allowance to the corner.*

*These will produce a 4-7/8" triangle. (This measurement is taking from point to square corner). We will mate these to the DARK triangles to complete the four "star points". The 4-1/2" squares will fill in the blanks with the BACKGROUND squares in the four corners and the MEDIUM in the centre.*



*Easy! As I designed this with only one star, you will need 18 of the 12-1/2" stars for the twin size. This means you will need 72 star points (4-1/2") to complete.*

*You can slot in any orphan block as long as it measures the 12-1/2". HAVE FUN WITH IT!!*
