 Clue 3

We are pulling a bit of the Clue 2 block and making it larger to create a new block. You will need to print off the larger “kite” for this clue and use the “recs” part of our tri-recs tool. This looks hard, but truly is simple once we “break it down”. We will be using only our BACKGROUND and MAIN fabrics today. We are finished with all other fabrics.


Let’s cut (four of these):

BACKGROUND	
6-1/2” WOF strips	3-4
Using the “recs” tool, cut triangles**	4 sets (8 triangles)
Using the “squarish” template, cut units**	4 each way for 8
AND 6-1/2” squares	4
MAIN COLOUR	
6-1/2” WOF strips	2
Using the larger “kite” template, cut kites	4
Using the “recs” tool, cut triangles**	4 sets (8 triangles)

**Please leave your strips folded and cut two at a time, we need specific left and right units.

Cutting help with the “squarish” template:

These are cut with my fabric folded right sides together so I am cutting two units at a time.



Let’s use these squarish units and the recs in the MAIN colour for some 6-1/2” units. You should have four each way. You may need to “square” these back up.

Now for that larger kite, we will cut this the same way we cut in clue 2, using the 6-1/2" WOF strip. We will add those MAIN recs units to each side to make this a 6-1/2" square.

Once we have these assembled, we are ready to put this unit together. We should have FOUR completed units today.

We are forming what resembles an arrow. This will mimic the stars we created in clue 2.

Deconstructed:



Complete, we should have four units that measure 12-1/2".
