 Fabric Requirements

When I started this quilt, I was trying to design a “medallion” type with a centre design surrounded by borders. I will tell you that’s not entirely what we ended up with. We will be using some larger blocks to accomplish a beautiful quilt. This is going to be so much fun.

This would be gorgeous in solids. I am using one solid, but a couple prints (one reads solid) added in because they are the colours I wanted. I am using a dark background with a light contrast. I will use blue as my focus. I will label our fabrics: BACKGROUND, FOCUS, and CONTRAST. I design most of my quilts on a square, and this one is no different, but I did do a rectangle version and it works. You may want to wait til the reveal to decide which column(s) to rearrange or leave out...

I am offering this in three sizes, 10”, 12”, and 15” finished blocks. These equal a larger lap, queen, and king sizes. Just have fun with it. I have included the binding requirements in the FOCUS fabric. You will need to take that into account, there is at least 3/4 yards of binding.

<i>BACKGROUND</i>	<i>2-3/4 yards</i>	<i>3-3/4 yards</i>	<i>5-3/4 yards</i>
<i>FOCUS</i>	<i>2-1/2 yards</i>	<i>3-1/4 yards</i>	<i>4-1/4 yards</i>
<i>CONTRAST</i>	<i>2 yards</i>	<i>3 yards</i>	<i>4 yards</i>

We don’t need any special tools, although we have one “funky” block, I will either give you a template or tell you how to draw your own...easy peasy!

Here are my choices:

CONTRASTs (on top)

FOCUS (blue print)

BACKGROUND (dark blue)
