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Fabric Requirements

For this amazing design, we will need three fabrics. You can use any fabrics as long as they have contrast with each other. I will be labelling them: LIGHT, MEDIUM, and DARK, although you will not have to stick to these “hues” if you don’t want to. If you pinned me down, I might say as designed, the LIGHT is the background. You may want to think about that before choosing a large print for this position. I would say you can use solids, small to medium prints, directional fabrics with caution, or just about anything you want as long as there is contrast between your fabrics. If you choose monochrome, you will want definite light, medium, and dark fabrics. Black and white with a pop of colour, navy and light blue with a bold print, seriously the sky is the limit!

I have designed one pattern in three sizes... the block sizes will determine your finished size. I have designed a border for this and included it in the requirements. The corners are pieced but the sides are strips, easy. The fabric requirements INCLUDE the border and the sizes are reflected AFTER border. This is designed as a square, but you can easily make it a rectangle by adding a row or two, but I would wait til reveal to see what you want to add. This design is simple enough you can easily make it your story with your fabrics and quilting. Binding amounts are not included.

Here’s what we need:

	12” blocks 72” square	15” blocks 90” square	18” blocks 108” square
LIGHT	2-3/4 yards	3-3/4 yards	5-3/4 yards
MEDIUM	1-1/2 yards	2 yards	2-1/4 yards
DARK	1-3/4 yards	2-1/2 yards	3-3/4 yards
