

Double Down
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 Clue 2

With this clue comes two more blocks. Clue 2A is opposite to Clue 1B and I am easily confused, so I decided to make them in two different clues. Block B for this clue is an easy straightforward 4-patch. We will be assembling four of each clue for a total of eight blocks.

Block A: Please cut from BOTH light and dark fabrics.

We will grab the extra 4-patch units from Clue 1 to assemble these snails. Remember these will "swirl" in the opposite direction as Clue 1. Here are our round by round pics.

<i>Sub-cut to 3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>8</i>		
<i>AND 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" units</i>	<i>8</i>		
<i>4-1/4" WOF strips</i>		<i>3</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 4-1/4" squares</i>		<i>8</i>	
<i>AND 4-1/4" x 8" units</i>		<i>8</i>	
<i>5" WOF strips</i>			<i>3</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 5" squares</i>			<i>8</i>
<i>AND 5" x 9-1/2" units</i>			<i>8</i>

These are very easy to assemble, no triangles... we are ready to sew! Starting with the smallest squares and rectangles, we will assemble some units that look like this:

Once these units are assembled, they should measure 6-1/2", 8", or 9-1/2" and be pressed toward the dark fabric.

Now to finish these up:



You will have four of these and they should measure 12-1/2", 15-1/2", or 18-1/2" now.

Press these with a pinwheel in the centre and they will be flat. Easy, right!
