

Double Down
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Clue 4 REVEAL

You should have plenty of fabric left for the border. I have included the cutting and assembly instructions in this clue for the border. BUT... here is this lovely design BEFORE the border. Please find the border instructions on page 2-3.



You will know the “swirl” blocks are laid correctly if you can see a “tulip” in all four corners.

I got mine together and decided it was large enough and I stopped here. Although I did stitch those corners for you so you could see how to do them.

Hopefully, you have scraps for these, but if you don't cut the smallest WOF you can for your chosen size (eg 3-1/2" for 12" blocks. Etc)

We will assemble our border corners just like we did some of the larger blocks. Here are progression pics.



Here is it with the top corners laid out. We will stitch the WOF strips (LIGHT and MEDIUM) on the long sides and that will be the border on all four sides. You will need to measure and find the average and cut these long strips to your length.
