

## Three Wishes

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Fabric Requirements

*This beauty requires three fabrics. The key to the entire design and secondary designs is CONTRAST. The fabrics must contrast each other. This doesn't have to be light, medium, and dark... they could all three be mediums if there is plenty of contrast! When I designed this, I chose a medium/dark background with a light accent and a medium contrast. You can use your light and dark wherever you choose... flipflop it around, shake it up... can't wait to see! Prints, solids, geometric... even directional (with a bit of extra care) fabrics will work. Your stash (or quilt shop) is the limit... jump out of your box and try something new!*

*I am offering two sizes for this design. 9" blocks for a quilt starting at 63" and 12" blocks for a quilt starting at 84". I designed this on the square. You can make a rectangle, but you will need to add a row or two. I can make suggestions along the way for you. The binding is included in the contrast fabric, for each of the smaller designs.*

**Remember CONTRAST, CONTRAST, CONTRAST!**

*Here's what we need:*

	63" square (9")	84" square (12")
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	2-1/2 yards	4 yards
<b>ACCENT</b>	3/4 yard	1-1/4 yards
<b>CONTRAST</b>	2-1/4 yards	3-1/4 yards

Special tools:

Curves (opt) template provided  
Tri-recs Tool (optional)

*Here are my fabrics:*

Dark on top: **CONTRAST**  
Cream print: **ACCENT**  
Bottom Blue: **BACKGROUND**
