Two "Colour" Quilt Challenge
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Clue 2

For this clue, we will be creating 20 (yes, twenty) of the same blocks. You can either assemble these in a 9-patch manner (note the second charts) or use rectangle units. I'm giving you options to use smaller scraps.

Larger scrap cutting:

BACKGROUND	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>20</i>	
<i>3-1/2" x 6-1/2" units</i>	<i>20</i>	
<i>3-1/2" x 9-1/2" units</i>	<i>20</i>	
<i>4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>20</i>
<i>4-1/2" x 8-1/2" units</i>		<i>20</i>
<i>4-1/2" x 12-1/2" units</i>		<i>20</i>
CONTRAST	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>20</i>	
<i>3-1/2" x 6-1/2" units</i>	<i>20</i>	
<i>4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>20</i>
<i>4-1/2" x 8-1/2" units</i>		<i>20</i>

Smaller scrap cutting:

BACKGROUND	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>100</i>	
<i>4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>100</i>
CONTRAST	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>60</i>	
<i>4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>60</i>

Here's our layout for these...I used the rectangles, for the 9-patch with the squares, just make sure your completed block has your fabrics in the same position as mine. Here we go!

You should have 20 of these no matter your cutting choice... you can even mix and match, just make sure you have 20 ready before the next clue... These should measure 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" now and be pressed flat, we may need to flip these seams later.

Please make sure if you use the 9 patch method that your contrast fabrics stay in the centre with that one background "corner".
