 Clue 3

*We have two more sets of blocks for this clue. These are quite easy and fast. I am so excited. I think I will also add the lattice and cornerstone cutting instructions if you choose to add these. I will be adding them as I love the look (and the fact that Jesus is our Cornerstone). Let's just get busy cutting and sewing.*

*Block A: First chart is for two fabrics, please cut the required amount from EACH fabric.*

<b>FABRICS 1 &amp; 2</b>	<b>9" blocks</b>	<b>12" blocks</b>
<i>3-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 3-7/8" squares</i>	<i>4</i>	
<i>3-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>4</i>	
<i>AND 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" units</i>	<i>4</i>	
<i>4-7/8" WOF strips</i>		<i>1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 4-7/8" squares</i>		<i>4</i>
<i>4-1/2" WOF strips</i>		<i>Scraps + 1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>4</i>
<i>AND 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" units</i>		<i>4</i>
<b>FABRIC 3</b>	<b>9" blocks</b>	<b>12" blocks</b>
<i>3-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>Scraps or 1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>4</i>	
<i>4-1/2" WOF strips</i>		<i>Scraps or 1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>4</i>

We need the -7/8" squares and make some HST units. I drew one diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter fabric (to see it better), then stitched a scant 1/4" to the left and right of the line. Cutting on the line, pressing toward the dark and trimming to 3-1/2" or 4-1/2" finishes our HST units. You will have eight HST units.

We are ready to assemble these now!! EASY, QUICK, FUN!



Four of these 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" blocks now, pressed away from the HST units for flatness.



Block B: This chart is for THREE fabrics, please cut required amount from EACH fabric.

FABRIC 1, 2, and 3	9" blocks	12" blocks
3-1/2" WOF strips	2	
Sub-cut to 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" units	8	
4-1/2" WOF strips		3
Sub-cut to 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" units		8

This is SIMPLE!!! We need to stitch these units together making sure the FABRIC 1 units stay in the middle. EASY... you should have eight of these 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" units pressed toward the centre.



Please use your scraps before cutting new WOFs. You may not need as many WOFs as I say.

Lattice:

<b>FABRIC 3</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>9-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>3</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" units</i>	<i>84</i>	
<i>12-1/2" WOF strips</i>		<i>3</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" units</i>		<i>84</i>

Cornerstones:

<b>FABRIC 2</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>1-1/2" WOF strips</i>	<i>2</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 1-1/2" squares</i>	<i>49</i>	
<i>1-1/2" WOF strips</i>		<i>2</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 1-1/2" squares</i>		<i>49</i>

Lattice and cornerstones ready to go!
