 Clue 6 REVEAL

We have one more straight border to cut for the larger sizes in each block size, but other than that, we are ready to layout and finish up this beauty. I love this design (as does my hubby!), can't wait to get it on the bed!

Final cutting: FINAL BORDER for largest sizes in each block size. If you choose this final border, you will need these strips to get to that final size. Hubby and I decided not to add the 4" final border, opting to do a 3" finished border in it's place to be the perfect size for our bed.

WOW, isn't this gorgeous!?!?!?



If you haven't done that final stitching in clue 5, you will need to do that before you assemble the border. **HOWEVER**, you can assemble the centre!! Here she is, first without the border, second complete with the first border. And finally, complete with the second plain border.

For those strip-sets we cut and stitched together, we need to cut them into 20-1/2" lengths for the 10" quilt and 24-1/2" for the 12" quilt. You will need 8 (eight) of these. We will use these to assemble the borders. I only had space to take a pic of half of one border, but you get the picture. Two will have one small square at each end. The other two will have two.



And here is the progress pic, with this first border on:



**I know the instructions say to use the BACKGROUND for the final border, but I used that black with the purple polka dots for a powerful statement around the outside. This is my ACCENT. You can use whatever you want! Have fun with it. You have enough BACKGROUND from the instructions, I just had enough of the black leftover to do that border.*

Final:



I truly wish you could see the vibrant purple and the purple polka dots on the black fabric. It is so much more beautiful than words can describe. I used a multitude of white tone on tone fabrics, all others are yardage from the same bolt.
