

*Give Way*  
*Two "Colour" Challenge Quilt*

 Clue 4

*We are on the downhill slope now... almost there. We have two more sets of blocks to complete in this clue. All small scrap-friendly. We need four Block A units and five Block B units. These should be easy.*

*Block A: four of this set*

<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-1/2" squares</i>	<i>12</i>	
<i>3-7/8" squares</i>	<i>10</i>	
<i>4-1/4" squares</i>	<i>2</i>	
<i>4-1/2" squares</i>		<i>12</i>
<i>4-7/8" squares</i>		<i>10</i>
<i>5-1/4" squares</i>		<i>2</i>
<b>CONTRAST</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-7/8" squares</i>	<i>10</i>	
<i>4-1/4" squares</i>	<i>2</i>	
<i>4-7/8" squares</i>		<i>10</i>
<i>5-1/4" squares</i>		<i>2</i>

*We need to grab 8 (eight) of the 3-7/8" (4-7/8") BACKGROUND and CONTRAST squares and make HSTs with them. These should measure 3-1/2" or 4-1/2" when we finish them. We need to cut the remaining two squares on ONE diagonal for get four triangles in each colour.*

*Remember to stitch a scant 1/4" to the left and right of the line, cut on the line and press toward the darker fabric...*

*We will start the larger squares the same way as a HST, we will just cut them differently. Let's do that first step...*





For these though, we need to cut these on *BOTH* diagonals, even though we didn't stitch both ways. These will give us triangles that are exactly the same size as the triangles we cut with those left over squares from "step 1" (those HST units).

Once these triangles are stitched to those larger triangles, these should be pressed toward the single triangle and squared to 3-1/2" or 4-1/2" now.



We are ready to lay out our *FOUR* blocks...

Once stitched in a 9-patch manner, three rows with three blocks... press these away from the centre, seems to make it more flat this way. Our completed blocks should measure 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" now.

*Block B: five (5) of these stars*

<b>ANY SCRAPS</b>	<i>9" blocks</i>	<i>12" blocks</i>
<i>3-1/2" squares</i>	5	
<i>4-1/2" squares</i>		5

We will be making "houses" with **20** those **BACKGROUND** and **ALL CONTRAST** squares using the contrast squares as our "roof".

Those **CONTRAST** squares need to have **ONE** diagonal line drawn on the back. The line needs to go centre to centre of our square sides. We will stitch **ON** that line (or just to the outside) and trim to our 1/4" seam allowance...



Once trimmed and pressed back, it's time to put another contrast square right beside it...

Repeating the process as before, we should not have changed the size of the original square.



Time to lay out these **FIVE** 9-1/2" or 12-1/2" (when stitched together). We will grab those **ANY SCRAPS** squares for the centre. Press away from the houses (toward the centre) for better points.
