For this clue, we will be doing two sets of blocks, but they are VERY SIMILAR. We will cut both blocks at once, so please watch your assembly instructions for each block. We will need four of each block for a total of eight blocks. Too much fun, I'd say!

We will create some flying geese units with our BACKGROUND largest squares (should be 4) and the MEDIUM 1 smaller squares, AND our DARK largest squares and the MEDIUM 1 smaller squares. You will need 16 of those smaller squares with each colour (four each larger square). We will use the no waste flying geese method, drawing one diagonal line on those MEDIUM 1 squares. OR, you can cut the larger squares on both diagonals and the smaller squares on one diagonal to get your flying geese units.

Once the geese are assembled and trimmed to 2-1/4" x 3-7/8" (for the 10" blocks) or 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (for the 12" blocks), we are ready to assemble some stars.

Please keep the flying geese units and the side squares the same fabric...

Finally, we will add those final rectangles to all eight of these stars.



Complete, these eight blocks will measure 10-1/2" or 12-1/2". Please press away from the centre.
