 Clue 3

For this clue, we will be doing one (set of) block. We need fourteen (14), so we will get these complete and that's it for this clue. These are quite easy as they are squares and rectangles. We will start with some strip-sets, add rectangles, finally squares to create them. EASY!

Grab your fabrics and let's go! Please use your leftover WOF and scraps first, cutting new WOFs only when you need to.

Block A: (only one for this clue) we need 14 of these.

First things first, let's grab those WOFs we didn't already "sub-cut". You should have DARK and COMPLIMENT strips uncut.

We need to stitch these along the LONG sides to make some strip-sets. You should have three or four of these now, depending on your size.



I have four sets as I am doing the larger size. You will need to sub-cut these now to 3" x 5-1/2" OR 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" units now. You will need 42 of these units.

You should have cut 42 rectangles in the DARK as well. We will mate these 2-patch units to the rectangles like this:

We are ready to lay out our block!!



Please make sure those small COMPLIMENT squares make a diagonal line in your block.

Complete, these should measure 10-1/2" or 12-1/2". You should have FOURTEEN (14) of these. Press these flat, I did pinwheel all centre seams.
