 Clue 2

More large cuts for this clue. We will create two more sets of chevrons and some large triangle in a square units. Sixteen more blocks complete at the finish of this clue. You can pick up the template from the template tab on the website. Please print at 100% with no scaling, from a computer (not mobile device) so you have control over your print options. Blocks A and B are those chevrons. Block C will be those triangle in a square units.

Blocks A and B:

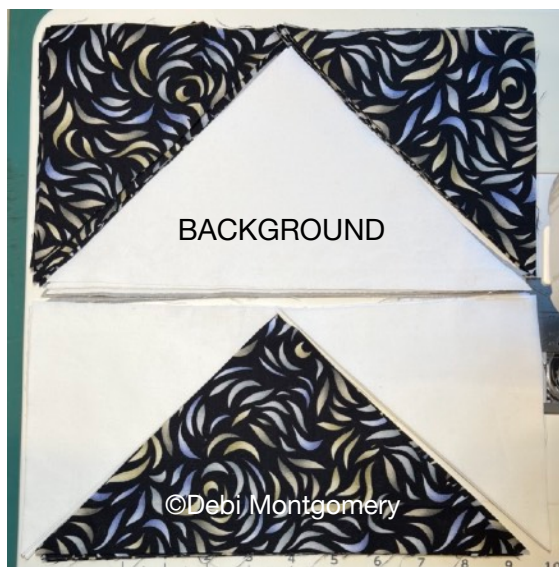
DARK	<i>8" blocks</i>	<i>10" blocks</i>
<i>9-1/4" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 9-1/4" squares</i>	<i>2</i>	
<i>Cut squares on BOTH diagonals for triangles</i>	<i>8</i>	
<i>4-7/8" WOF strips</i>	<i>1</i>	
<i>Sub-cut to 4-7/8" squares</i>	<i>8</i>	
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>	<i>16</i>	
<i>11-1/4" WOF strips</i>		<i>1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 11-1/4" squares</i>		<i>2</i>
<i>Cut squares on BOTH diagonals for triangles</i>		<i>8</i>
<i>5-7/8" WOF strips</i>		<i>Scraps + 1 or 2</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 5-7/8" squares</i>		<i>8</i>
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>		<i>16</i>

COMPLIMENT	<i>8" blocks</i>	<i>10" blocks</i>
<i>11-1/4" WOF strips</i>		1
<i>Sub-cut to 11-1/4" squares</i>		1
<i>Cut squares on BOTH diagonals for triangles</i>		4
<i>5-7/8" WOF strips</i>		<i>Scraps or 1</i>
<i>Sub-cut to 5-7/8" squares</i>		4
<i>Cut squares on ONE diagonal for triangles</i>		8

These are more chevrons, just like Clue 1 but easier! We need FOUR in each colour way again, but the placement is super easy. Again, the flying geese units should measure 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" or 5-1/2" x 10-1/2", with our blocks complete at 8-1/2" or 10-1/2".

Four each colour way, same pressing as the Clue 1 units.

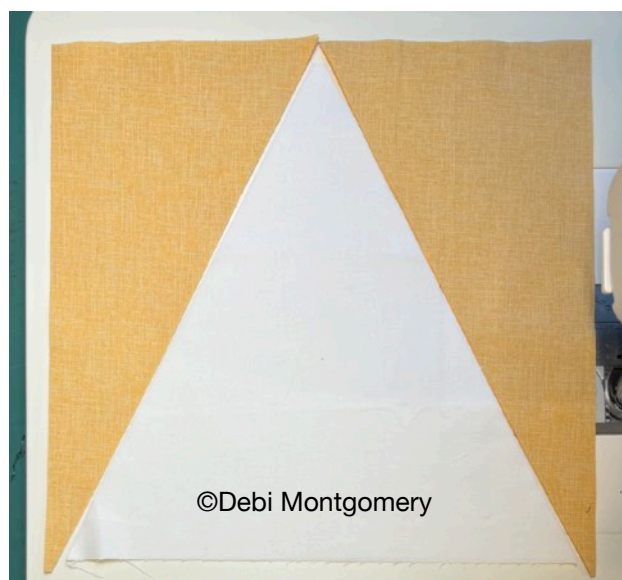


Block C is on page 4.

**Or leave your fabric folded and cut a set at a time, this gives us a left and right side as we are cutting mirror image. We need 8 sets.*



EIGHT of these. You may need to sliver trim back to the 8-1/2" or 10-1/2". These should be pressed toward the BOLD fabric.
