

Dynamite!
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Clue 5

We need twenty (20) of this one block, this will be the only one we will do for this clue. Twenty is quite a few! Easy units, put together to make an interesting “arrow”. I may add the border WOFs at the end, just because we are only completing one set of blocks. This is a lot of cutting, but well worth every minute!

Block A: twenty of these

Let's grab the largest squares in all three fabrics. We will be mating one BOLD with each of the BACKGROUND and DARK squares making sure they are Right Sides Together. We will cut each set on BOTH diagonals. You will have 40 sets of triangles - 20 BACKGROUND/BOLD and 20 DARK/BOLD.

We will start with the **BACKGROUND/BOLD** triangles. We need to stitch from the right angle (square) to the corner with the **BACKGROUND** on the top as it goes under the needle. For the second set, make sure the **BOLD** is on top as it goes under the needle. You should now have 40 larger triangles (20 each colour-way).

Now let's assemble 40 HSTs in each colour-way as well. We need 40 **BOLD** squares mated with 20 **BACKGROUND** and 20 **DARK** squares in the smaller (medium) size. These will be assembled using the draw one diagonal line and stitching 1/4" to the left and right of the line method. This will need to be trimmed to 3-1/4" or 3-7/8" now.

With the remaining squares in this size, please cut them on **ONE** diagonal for triangles. We will use these to complete our quarter square triangles we started at the top of this page. These will be trimmed to 3-1/4" or 3-7/8" now as well.



We have everything cut and ready to lay out and assemble our blocks. Remember, we are making 20 (TWENTY) of these! Complete for Clue 5, these should measure 8-1/2" or 10-1/2" and be pressed flat, this may be different for you than what I did.



Please make sure your **BOLD** fabrics make a beautiful "arrow" in the centre of the blocks.



And if you chose to do the border, you will need these WOFs for later:
