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Clue 4 REVEAL*

How was that for a quick project... sewing for three clues and BOOM! Done. I love this, I think mostly because of the fabrics I chose and the 3-D look they give. I am excited to share this with you. Remember this is set on point so we will assemble diagonal rows rather than "straight". We will finish off each row with setting or corner triangles. Here she is:



If you make two of each row, you will be ready to assemble. Finishing will be to rotate half 180° and stitch those two row 4s together. This will now be a rectangle. I did the 12" size, with no borders, this measures ~68" x 85".

You can add borders if you wish. I did four more of those blocks with two "dots" (half size) and used them as the cornerstones of a solid dark border. You can "frame" your centre with a solid border (ACCENT fabric), but I wouldn't make this one any larger than 3" or so.

ENJOY and play with rotation to see what you can come up with!

There are multiple "on point" tutorials on YouTube to help you with stitching this together. AND, I will help every step of the way!!

I pre-assembled mine (before 1 January 2025) so I may be using a different project to help you!!
