We will be assembling twelve log cabin blocks for this clue. Since we have a bit of cutting and stitching to do, we will stop at these 12 blocks. Grab those twelve RED squares we didn't use in Clue 3 and we will cut from there. Be as scrappy as you wish with these.

We need those remaining 12 RED squares from Clue 3. We will be assembling log cabin blocks in this clue. We will start with our MEDIUM and RED squares then adding the next MEDIUM unit as shown. IF you begin as shown, you should be able to rotate the piece you just added to the "bottom" and add the next unit to the side.



First LIGHT unit.



You can see I rotated that light unit to the "bottom" and added the next one... Keep adding in this manner keeping the MEDIUM on one side and the LIGHT on the other.



Next MEDIUM...





Our completed blocks should measure 9-1/2", 10-1/2", or 12-1/2" now and be pressed away from that red square again, just like the courthouse steps from Clue 3.

Notice how the MEDIUMs are on one side and the LIGHTs are on the other. Also, that I used scrappy strips for these, using what I had that appeared to be the same hue.

You should have TWELVE (12) of these log cabin blocks measuring correctly.
