Let's Solve this Mystery!

I am so loving this design. As I was laying it out for the map, my hubby said it was amazing and the colours were perfect! That makes me happy.

One place to play would be with your log cabin "HST" units. These can be rotated for a totally different look. I love this look, so I am leaving mine like this. How gorgeous! Layout on this page, row by row instructions start on page 2.



Let's get started. We have laid this out "on point", meaning we are creating diagonal rows rather than straight. If we assemble TWO of each row, we will finish with two of each: rows 1 through 5 for ten rows total. We will start with ONE corner triangle, the "snowflake", and TWO setting triangles.



Please assemble TWO of each row. We will be making half of our quilt with each set of rows.



And our last set of rows...

If you assembled two of each row, you will have two sets of FIVE rows. This is our top left and bottom right “halves” of our design. Rotate one half and finish with that final seam down the centre.

I love this and can’t wait to spend many a winter night under my quilt!
